- The PMP® examination is comprised of 200 multiple-choice questions. Of the 200 questions, 25 are considered pretest questions. Pretest questions do not affect the score and are used in examinations as an effective and legitimate way to test the validity of future examination questions.
- All pretest questions are unmarked and randomly placed throughout the examination.
- The 200 questions cover the vast body of project management terms, concepts, principles, and application.
- The duration of the exam is 4 hours and the exam is computer based.
- Results are provided at the conclusion of the exam.

Eligibility Overview

A secondary degree (high school diploma, associate's degree, or the global equivalent) with at least five years of project management experience, with 7,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.

OR

A four-year degree (bachelor's degree or the global equivalent) and at least three years of project management experience, with 4,500 hours leading and directing projects and 35 hours of project management education.
